






## THE PANDEMIC KEEPS SHAKING YOUTH WORK TO THE CORE








N = 1.042 youth workers and youth leaders. Data snapshot March 2021.






Q. How many of the young people you normally work with do you currently still reach with your youth work?










Q. In your opinion and context, how well has youth work as a field been supported during the crisis so far?








